RULES & INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

ADMISSION TO I M.B; B.S COURSE

AT C.U. SHAH MEDICAL COLLEGE, SURENDRANAGAR

FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2009-10 In NRI QUOTA

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1.1 In MBBS course, 15% of the seats will be filled in by the category of N. R. I students(NRI quota) who satisfy the eligibility criteria as per Medical Council of India, Hon. Supreme Court of India and/or Government of Gujarat. (If the candidate is NRI sponsored, the sponsor should be completely responsible for the education of the candidate in the course of MBBS)
- 1.2 The Institution is affiliated to SAURASHTRA UNIVERSITY, Kalavad Road, Rajkot. For all academic matters, the rules and ordinances of the university will apply, in toto, to the affiliated courses run by the Institution. This includes the requirement of minimum 75% attendance and 35% marks in internal examinations to be eligible to appear in University examinations.
- 1.3 The total duration of M.B;B.S course will be 4 ½ years, divided in three phases as under:

- 1.4 There will be a rotating internship of one year following successful completion of the course. The degree of M.B;B.S will be awarded by Saurashtra University on satisfactory completion of the internship.
- 1.5 Students will not be permitted to take up any employment or carry out any private business during the entire period of their student-ship.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICATION:

- 2.1 Candidates seeking admission in NRI / NRI sponsored quota should have passed the qualifying examination from Gujarat or equivalent examination from elsewhere with at least 50% marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry & Biology (Theory) and also should have passed in the subject of English.
- 2.2 The candidate should have completed 17 years of age by 31st December of the year of admission to be eligible to be admitted in the current year. The following procedure will be adopted in case of under age students:
 - a) Their names will be included in the current merit list.
 - b) If an under age candidate becomes eligible to be admitted as per his/her merit position, he/she will be offered admission
 - c) He/she will be enrolled only after he/she completes the age of 17 years and the rules governing granting of terms by Saurashtra University will be applicable in such cases.
- 2.3 Those applying for admission in NRI quota with qualifying examination from Boards other than Gujarat Secondary Education Board, should obtain and submit the certificate of equivalence from Gujarat Higher Secondary Board/competent authority at the time of application, ascertaining that the qualifying examination passed by him/her is equivalent to HSC of Gujarat Board. Such candidates also should obtain eligibility certificate from Saurashtra University with in the stipulated date.
- 2.4 Incomplete applications and applications received after the stipulated last date will be summarily rejected with out any further communication.

3. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION :

- 3.1 Every application for admission should be filled in, only in the prescribed form available from the Institution.
- 3.2 The application duly filled in by the candidate (in own hand-writing in block letter in blue/black ink) should be accompanied by the prescribed application fee and clear photo-copies of supporting documents as under (non-returnable) and 5 recent passport-size colour photographs.
 - Copy of Mark-sheet of qualifying examination
 - Copy of mark-sheet of S.S.C or equivalent examination
 - Copy of school leaving certificate / Proof of date of birth
 - If self is NRI, copy of passport
 - If parents are NRI, copy of passport of Father/ mother
 - If sponsored by NRI, copy of passport of relative
 - If sponsored by NRI relative, copy of notarized affidavit
 - Self-addressed stamped envelope
 - Equivalency certificate, if applicable, from concerned authorities

3.3 Applications with necessary enclosures should be **submitted personally** to:

3.4 The information about any modification of marks by the concerned Board should be submitted along with supporting documents as an addendum, at least a day prior to the counselling session.

3.5 The applications complete in all respects should reach the Institution on or before the prescribed last date, as published in the advertisement. Applications received after the last date will not be entertained.

4. COUNSELING FOR ADMISSION & ADMISSION:

4.1 The date, time and venue of first and subsequent counselling/s would be published in News Paper/s &/or Notice Board /website of the Institution.

4.2 Call letters for counseling will be sent by the Institution to concerned candidates. Even if the candidates do not receive the call letter due to any reason, they will have to appear for the counseling on the basis of announcement in news papers/Notice Board /website and the Institution will not be responsible for the non-receipt of call letters and absence of candidates on the day of counseling.

4.3 At the time of counseling, the candidate is required to produce all the relevant documents in original along with 2 sets of Photostat copies. A candidate procuring admission will have to submit all the original documents to the Institution which will be retained till he/she completes the course or leave the course with prior permission and approval. If a candidate fails to submit any of the relevant documents, he/she may forfeit his/her claim for admission. Admission is subject to verification and approval of the original documents submitted by the candidate/s.

4.4 The admission of the candidates who have passed qualifying examination from boards other than Gujarat Higher Secondary Board, will be subject to submission of provisional eligibility certificate from Saurashtra University, within the mutually stipulated and agreed upon date and if a candidate fails to submit the same, his/her admission may be cancelled and the seat may be offered to candidate/s from the waiting list.

4.5 The candidate will have to pay the advance component of fees as decided and announced by the management(approved or subject to approval by the relevant committee) at the time of counselling and give an undertaking to pay the balance amount payable within a mutually agreed upon date. If he/she fails to remit the fees as above, his/her admission may be cancelled.

- 4.6 The tuition fees for NRI candidates seeking admission to MBBS course in the current year is proposed to be : **Rs 5 lakhs**(Rs five lakhs only) or corresponding foreign currency payable **per semester** (Totalling 9 instalments).
- 4.7 The other fees/deposits applicable to college as well as hostels, as decided by management will be announced during the process of admission. In case of failures during the course, fees will be collected as per instructions of the Relevant committee.

Any legal dispute arising out of the admission procedure of I MBBS course at C. U. Shah Medical College, Surendranagar shall be under the jurisdiction of Judicial Magistrate, Surendranagar, Gujarat.

COLLEGE: The college is built with a space of about 321007 Sq.M construction. (The whole campus consisting of Medical college, Physiotherapy college, Hospital, wards, OTs, residential facilities, hostels etc is in a plot of 33 acres, congruent.)

The college houses all pre & paraclinical departments with all infrastructural facilities including central library with air-conditioned reading hall, , blood bank, MEU centre, 4 lecture halls(3 of 120 each and 1 of 250 capacity), Auditorium to seat 750 (all with audio-visual facilities) and examination hall to seat 300 etc

The central library has more than 15000 books in various subjects and also subscribes to nearly 110 (Indian & Foreign) journals/publications.

It has 3 Boys hostels to accommodate 390 boys and 1 girls' hostel to accommodate 110 girls (Total capacity = 500 & fully furnished). Three round the clock mess services are available for the students and staff.

It has accommodation for 150 residents and 100 interns. Provisions to accommodate more than 50% of staff members are also available. The campus also houses an animal house, mortuary with PM facilities, work-shop and an incinerator. Out door and indoor games facilities are also available in the campus

HOSPITAL : The teaching hospital viz: C.U. SHAH MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL is also run by the same trust which runs the medical college. It is with 500 teaching beds as under:

Over and above, it also runs 12 semispecial/special rooms

OPD & Indoor

It has an average daily OPD of about 800 patients and about 80% Occupancy rate on an average in the indoor facilities. The casualty (fully equipped and with 20 beds) runs round the Clock . All the records (OPD,Indoor, Laboratory) are computerized and “on-line”

Diagnostic / therapeuticIt has all basic diagnostic facilities like Pathology, Microbiology & Facilities Biochemical investigative facilities, basic Radiodiagnostic facilities and also advanced techniques like CAT scan, MRI, Digital X-ray, Cardiac dopplers , TMT, Pulse oximeters etc . It runs 10 fully functional operation theatres . Online Oxygen, Nitrous oxide and suction facilities are provided along with Standby facilities like Oxygen cylinders and suction machines.

All ICU/ICCU are fully equipped with central monitoring stations and necessary diagnostic & therapeutic equipments like pulse oximeter, online oxygen. Suction, ventilator, defibrillators etc

It runs a pharmacy of its own which caters to OPD as well as indoor patients. CSSD and also sterilization facilities attached to OTs are available. A central laundry, kitchen and other corollary services are available. There are 5 fully equipped ambulances for round the clock services . Weekly “Hospital on wheels “ services are provided to various villages in the District

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE: From the very first examination the academic performance of our students was exemplary. The results are always better than the other 2 institutions affiliated to the same University and many meritorious positions are occupied by the students of this Institution.

The students graduating from this Institution will be able to compete with students from M.P. Shah Medical College, Jamnagar & P D U Medical College, Rajkot for Post-graduate seats in Medical Faculty of Saurashtra University.
